It is a secure and private site. When finished planning, print your plan and take to an attorney to complete your will. Please remember to include the parish endowment fund or capital campaign in your will. **2. Power of Attorney:** This is needed in case of incapacity in order to have someone take care of your daily affairs. **3. Advanced Directives:** This is important for your family to know your wishes in medical situations and it gives someone the ability to carry out your wishes.
