Charitable Giving Using Your IRA: When naming beneficiaries of your IRA it may be best to name the parish as a beneficiary or one of the beneficiaries. If your children are a beneficiary they will be taxed on what they receive. Even if they set up their remainder in a stretch IRA there will still be taxes due. There are ways that the remainder can go into a charitable remainder trust set up by your will in which your children will receive payments for a length of time and then the remainder goes to charity. This needs to be set up in your will by an estate attorney. Praying PACEM IN TERRIS

A further consequence of man's personal dignity is his right to engage in economic activities suited to his degree of responsibility. The worker is likewise entitled to a wage that is determined in accordance with the precepts of justice. This needs stressing. The amount a worker receives must be sufficient, in proportion to available funds, to allow him and his family a standard of living consistent with human dignity. Pope Pius XII expressed it in these terms: "Nature imposes work upon man as a duty, and man has the corresponding natural right to demand that the work he does shall provide him with the means of livelihood for himself and his children. Such is nature's categorical imperative for the preservation of man." (20)
