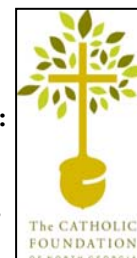

Charitable Gift Annuities give you additional income:

If you are over 65 and have \$10,000 or more to invest, possibly from a CD that is coming due, you may want a Charitable Gift Annuity which will give you higher rates than a CD, will give you a large tax deduction and provide you with quarterly fixed payments for the rest of your life. Here are some sample rates based on your age: Age 65-4.7%; Age 70-5.1%; Age 75-5.8%; Age 80-6.8%; Age 90 and older-9%. At your death, the remainder of the Gift Annuity can go to the parish endowment fund and other charities.
