Hunger Walk/Run

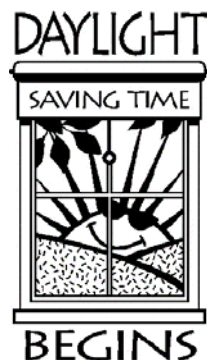
