

Charitable Gift Annuities vs CD's: If you have CD's that you are planning on leaving to the parish, please take a look at establishing a Charitable Gift Annuity. With a CGA, you will receive quarterly fixed payments for the rest of your life. Part of the payment is tax free. You also receive a nice charitable deduction that you can use the year you establish the Annuity or



it can be carried over for 5 years. The rate of payment on the Gift Annuity is based on your age. Sample rates: Age 65 - 4.7%; Age 70 -5.1%; Age 75 - 5.8%; Age 80 - 6.8%; Age 85 - 7.8%; Age 90 and older - 9%. At your death the remainder of the CGA will go to the parish endowment fund. This is a much better method of making a gift than a CD. You need to be 65 or older and the minimum investment is \$10,000.
