Every person bears God's image, every person is a unique gift from God. And everyone has a need to express their spiritual nature, nurtured by faith in Jesus.

- \* Practice Christ-like hospitality. Autism can be an isolating disorder for the whole family.
- \* Use people first language—"A person with autism".
- \* Some people may be more aware of lights, sounds, scents. Be respectful of their sensitivities.
- \* Some individuals may need extra space in the pew or to take a break. Sometimes a tactile object can provide centering and calming.
- \* Persons who are non-verbal can receive the sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation. They can show their spiritual understanding through gesture or respectful temperament.

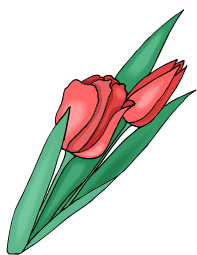
