This is a trust that one creates to pay out to a charity now for a number of years and at the end of the period the assets in the trust revert to the children or the grandchildren. This can be set up to begin while you are alive or it can be set up to begin when you have passed. This trust can save families capital gains and gift taxes. It is a wonderful tool to pass assets to your heirs while currently helping your parish with a building fund or debt reduction fund.
