



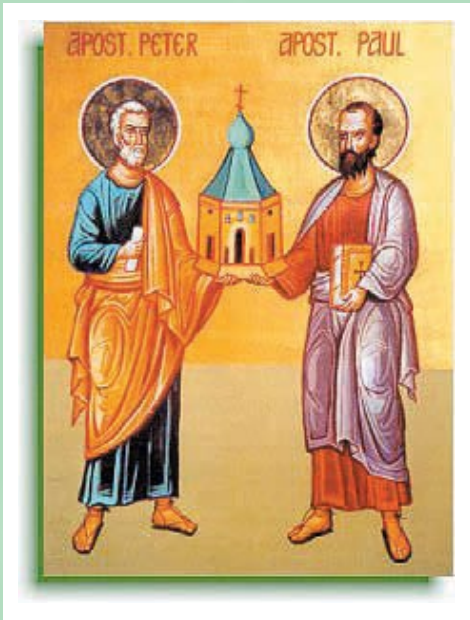
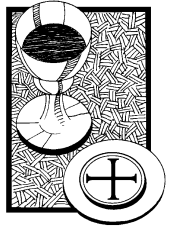

Why do retirement accounts make good gifts to the parish? IRAs, 401Ks and other retirement accounts are taxable to heirs unless the heir is a charity. Taxes on these funds can be up to 60% or more so these are not good accounts to leave to your children. It is better to leave insurance policies to children because they go directly to the child at death with no taxes due. Leave the retirement account to the parish and no taxes will be due on that distribution.
