Charitable Gift Annuities provide you cash during your life and go to the parish at your death. If you have CDs that you were planning to leave to a charity, when the CD comes due consider investing in a Charitable Gift Annuity. You will receive quarterly payments that are partially tax free and you receive a nice



charitable deduction when you establish the CGA. It can also be carried over for the next 5 years. The rates are based on your age when you establish the annuity. You have to be 65 years of age and have a minimum of \$10,000 to invest. The rate at 65 is 4.9% and if you are 90 or older the rate is 9%. Thoughts on Stewardship

You may recall in Daniel where God writes on the wall an unreadable message to King Belshazzar. He calls for Daniel to interpret God's message. Daniel translates, "You praised the gods of silver and gold, of bronze, iron, wood and stone...[temporal assets]. But you did not honor the God who holds in his hand your life and all your ways... You have been weighed on the scales and found wanting [eternal assets] (Daniel 5:23b,27). We must be ever mindful that on God's eternal scales, our accumulated, temporal assets, no matter how great they might be, weigh nothing. —E.G. "Jay" Link, *Who's In Charge Here?*
