“I Will Be With You Always” Mt 28:20

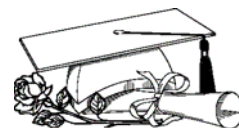

**Establish your own endowment fund:** It only takes \$5,000 to establish an endowment fund to benefit your parish or favorite ministry. Some people who do this give \$5,000 each year so that the fund reaches \$25,000 in 5 years. At that point, it will pay out annually to the designated parish or ministry. You can name the endowment after yourself or in memory of a loved one. Also, others can give to this endowment which will help it grow faster. A named endowment could also be started by the men or women’s club at the church or the Knights of Columbus.
