IRA's and other retirement accounts make excellent gifts for parishes as they go straight to the parish or the parish endowment fund and bypass probate. They are not taxable to the parish. If a retirement account is left to children or adult children they may have to pay heavy taxes on this gift. It is better to give heirs cash, securities or insurance and give the retirement account to the parish or the endowment fund. This is a win for both the family and the parish. Governmental authority, therefore, is a postulate of the moral order and derives from God. Consequently, laws and decrees passed in contravention of the moral order, and hence of the divine will, can have no binding force in conscience, since "it is right to obey God rather than men." Indeed, the passing of such laws undermines the very nature of authority and results in shameful abuse. As St. Thomas teaches, "In regard to the second proposition, we maintain that human law has the rationale of law in so far as it is in accordance with right reason, and as such it obviously derives from eternal law. A law which is at variance with reason is to that extent unjust and has no longer the rationale of law. It is rather an act of violence."

The school office at St. Peter Claver Regional School will be open during the summer Mondays-Thursdays, 9:00AM-3:00PM. Closed Fridays.

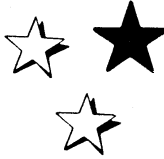
