Notes from The Catholic Foundation of North Georgia

The new tax laws provide a way for donors 70 1/2 or older to do a direct rollover from their IRA to the parish. The money cannot come to you. The advantage of this law is you do not pay taxes on the amount you roll directly to the parish. You could use this method to do

your annual giving or it could be used to contribute to a current campaign. If you would like to have the money go to the parish endowment fund, you can do a rollover directly to The Catholic Foundation of North Georgia for the parish endowment fund. This is very easy to do. The Foundation has a letter you can send to your IRA custodian in order to do this charitable rollover.
