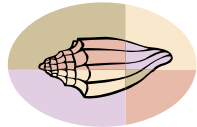
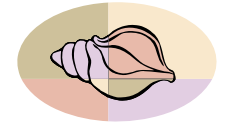
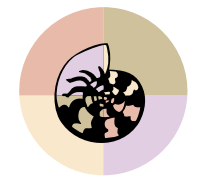

**Plan before you travel this summer. That includes making sure you have a will or that your will is up to date.** Now you can **plan your will online** at our website: [www.cfngalegacy.org](http://www.cfngalegacy.org). This is not creating your will but it will produce a document that you can take to your attorney to finalize your will. When thinking about your family, consider how the parish is part of your family, as it was the first place you were taken after birth to be baptized. You grew up in the parish receiving the other sacraments. Your social life many times is in the parish and the last place you will be before your burial will be the funeral Mass for you. So the parish is very much part of your family. In this case, when planning your will, please consider including the parish endowment fund in your will. You can leave money, a percent of your estate, an asset(s), or the remainder of your estate to the parish endowment fund.
