What is the Parish Endowment?

The Parish Endowment is a fund that is held at The Catholic Foundation of North Georgia to help provide for the future needs of the parish. Gifts to the endowment are called the "principal" or "corpus" of the fund, are not spent, and are invested so that the earnings and market growth from the gifts provide distributions for the intended purpose of the parish. It is meant to last into perpetuity. A great way to help this fund grow is including the parish endowment fund as a will bequest or as part of other estate plans. If you still need to plan your will you can do it confidentially on The Catholic Foundation website: www.cfnga.org. Then you will have a document to take to the attorney to finalize your will. 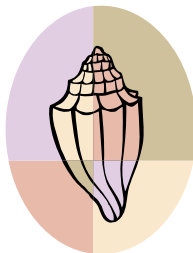
