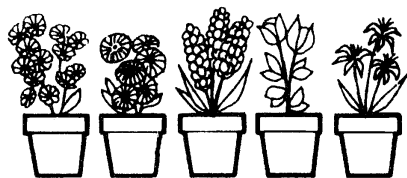
2014 Archbishop's Annual Appeal Update

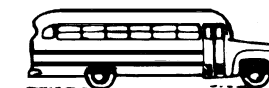
International Cultural & Heritage Celebration

Charitable Remainder Trust: If you have property you would like to sell, but want to avoid taxes, plus you would like income for the rest of your life then a charitable remainder trust may be what you need. An attorney creates the trust. Then property is placed in the trust so the trust owns the property. The property is then sold and the money invested so that you receive a percentage of the value of the trust at least annually. Remember this is a charitable trust so at your death or the death of your spouse, the remainder goes to your parish endowment fund and any other charities you have named in the trust.
