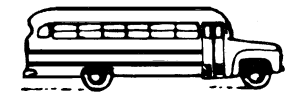
Parish Trip to Spain

It is better to leave IRA's to your parish and leave children insurance. Why? Children eventually have to pay taxes on the IRA and it can be up to 60%.
