Charitable Gift Annuities: If you are over 65 and would like to increase your income, receive a tax deduction and at the same time provide for a future gift to the parish endowment fund, then you might want to invest in a Charitable Gift Annuity. It takes \$10,000. You will receive fixed quarterly payments for life based on the income distribution rate which is based on your age.
