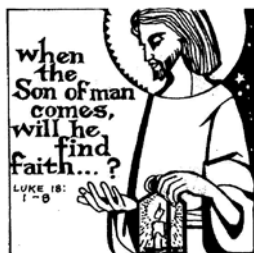

The new **American Tax Reform Act 2012 (ATRA)** that was passed the end of December tells us how to make a charitable gift from our IRA. We have simplified the information on our webpage so you can figure out how you can save or avoid taxes, care for your family and even make a charitable gift to the parish endowment fund. You can make a Charitable IRA rollover of up to \$100,000. The Catholic Foundation has the letter you need to send to the custodian of your IRA. The money will go directly from your IRA to the parish endowment fund or directly to the parish for a campaign or annual contribution. You do not have to count this distribution as income to you.
