How to set up an insurance policy to benefit the parish. The parish can accept paid up insurance policies that are no longer needed, but it is important to know that you can set up a new policy that will allow you to make a much larger gift to the parish than if you were to just give cash each year. The Catholic Foundation of North Georgia will be the owner of the policy and you will be the insured. The beneficiary will be the parish endowment fund or it could be for the parish capital campaign or debt reduction campaign. The premiums will be paid by the foundation and then you will send the foundation a check for the amount of the premium.. You will receive a tax deduction for the amount of the premium. Sounds good, doesn't it?
