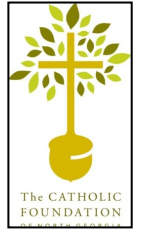
**Holy Week Pilgrimage for Immigrants**

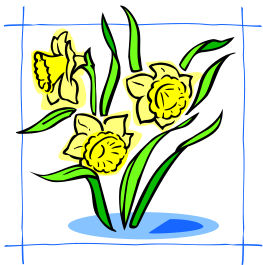
