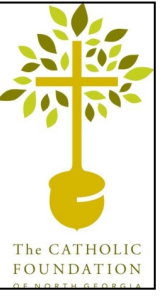

You can still contribute to your IRA for 2012. This must be done by April 15th. That will help you for this tax season. IRA's are a great way to prepare for retirement along with 401K's but they do not make good estate gifts to your children. If you leave your IRA to your children they will owe taxes on it. There is a way to provide for your children and leave a gift to the parish. If you have a large IRA or retirement plan, you can make your estate the beneficiary and have your Will direct it to a Charitable Remainder Trust that will pay out to your children for 20 years and then the remainder would go to the parish endowment fund.
