Une Église ouverte

L'évangile de ce dimanche nous parle de l'intimité de Jésus avec son Père et avec l'Esprit Saint. Ce qui est merveilleux, c'est que Jésus nous fait entrer dans cette intimité. Dieu veut être notre hôte intérieur. Il attend de nous que nous lui donnions la première place dans toute notre vie. Sa présence parmi nous et en nous est un privilège extraordinaire. Quand nous allons communier, nous recevons Dieu qui daigne habiter en nous. Nous n'aurions jamais pu imaginer un privilège aussi grand. Dans plusieurs de ses lettres, saint Paul nous rappelle que "nous sommes le temple de Dieu".

Si Jésus fait de nous sa demeure, c'est au nom de l'amour qu'il nous porte. Cela suppose de notre part un profond respect et une sincère docilité. Il est hors de question de déplaire à ce Dieu qui vient en nous par amour. Il est important de vivre en harmonie avec lui, une harmonie pleine de confiance et d'amour. C'est le message que Jésus nous adresse en ce jour : "Si quelqu'un m'aime, il restera fidèle à ma parole ; mon Père l'aimera, nous viendrons chez lui, et nous établirons chez lui notre demeure." Aimer, c'est avant tout écouter et accueillir la Parole du Christ. La Parole d'un tel Maître ne ressemble en rien à celle des hommes. A travers lui, c'est le Père qui vient à nous et se révèle.
