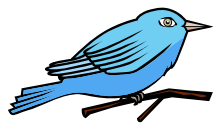

**Haitian Corner**

**Dieu nous fait revivre**

Les lectures de ce dimanche nous annoncent une bonne nouvelle : elles nous disent que notre Dieu est "Celui qui fait revivre". Dans le livre des Rois (1ère lecture), il s'agit du fils de la veuve de Sarepta. Celle-ci avait accepté de faire confiance à la foi d'Elie. Elle, qui n'avait qu'une poignée de farine et un peu d'huile, a quand même hébergé le prophète. En l'accueillant chez elle, elle lui a sauvé la vie. Or voilà que le fils de cette femme vient de mourir. Elle pense que le prophète Elie peut être responsable de cette situation. La suite, nous la connaissons : la prière d'Elie et le retour à la vie de l'enfant.

Dans l'Evangile, c'est Jésus qui arrive à Naïm. Il y croise un convoi funèbre. Il y a là une pauvre veuve qui accompagne son enfant au tombeau. Devant sa détresse, Jésus est saisi de pitié jusqu'au plus profond de lui-même. Il est Celui qui se fait proche de toutes les souffrances. Son intervention est efficace. Elle a pour effet de provoquer la résurrection du jeune homme. Tous sont impressionnés et rendent gloire à Dieu.

A travers ces deux récits, nous découvrons un Dieu qui a vu la misère de son peuple et qui agit. Le jeune homme mort c'est l'humanité tout entière, c'est chacun de nous. La mère, c'est l'Eglise de Jésus Christ. Le même Christ continue de venir à notre rencontre. Il est toujours agissant, toujours présent aujourd'hui comme autrefois. Il voit toutes les dérives de notre société actuelle, les violences, la course à l'argent et aux richesses par n'importe quel moyen, les familles qui se désagrègent... Dans notre humanité comme en chaque être humain, nous voyons se développer des germes de mort. Ils affaiblissent la vie de l'Esprit et celle-ci finit par être tuée.

Nous le voyons tous les jours : les forces du mal et celles de la vie sont bien présentes. Nous avons à nous protéger contre les premières, les éloigner et les faire disparaître. Nous avons surtout à nous ouvrir aux forces de la vie en rendant grâce à Dieu qui n'abandonne jamais ses fils malades. Nous nous rappelons que ce mois de juin est consacré au Sacré Cœur. Ce mois nous rappelle l'amour passionné de Jésus pour le monde. Avec lui, nous entrons dans l'ère de "la miséricorde pour tous".
