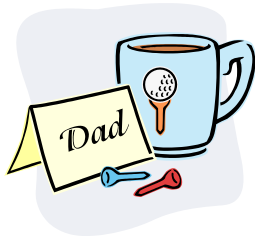

Haitian Corner
La miséricorde "pour tous".

Les lectures bibliques de ce dimanche nous parlent de la miséricorde "pour tous". Elle est offerte à tous, même aux plus grands pécheurs.

Cette miséricorde nous est révélée tout au long des textes bibliques de ce dimanche. Nous avons tout d'abord les reproches du prophète Nathan au roi David. Ce dernier avait fait mettre un de ses soldats à l'endroit le plus exposé du combat pour qu'il y soit tué. Le prophète vient lui reprocher cette attitude criminelle. Avant l'arrivée de Nathan, David ne semble pas en avoir pris conscience. C'est aussi ce qui nous arrive parfois. Notre conscience morale peut devenir très élastique et nous devenons inconscients de la nature de nos fautes. David a compris qu'il a péché et il l'a reconnu devant Dieu. La parole du prophète a réveillé sa conscience.

Voilà un message important pour nous aujourd'hui. Nous n'aimons pas que nos procédés tortueux soient mis au grand jour. Mais si le Seigneur nous montre notre péché, ce n'est pas pour nous enfoncer mais pour nous montrer son amour. Notre pape François nous a rappelé que Dieu ne se lasse jamais de nous accorder son pardon chaque fois que nous revenons à lui de tout notre cœur.

L'évangile est aussi une annonce de la miséricorde de Jésus. Nous le voyons invité chez un pharisien. Arrive une femme qui a la réputation d'être de mauvaise vie. Elle est toute remplie de douleur car elle voit bien que son existence est marquée par le péché. Mais elle ne reste pas enfermée dans sa douleur. Elle se tourne vers Jésus. Elle fait preuve d'un très grand amour envers lui. Elle est pleine de confiance en sa miséricorde. Tous les gestes affectueux qu'elle accomplit sont une manière de lui manifester son amour plein de reconnaissance.

Le pharisien ne voit pas ce qu'il y a de grand et de beau dans cette attitude. Il ne voit que la pécheresse et rien d'autre. Elle est définitivement enfoncée dans son péché et sa mauvaise réputation. Ce jugement ne lui laisse aucune chance. Mais ce n'est pas ainsi que Jésus voit les choses. Au lieu de dénoncer le péché, il commence par parler de sa générosité et de l'amour dont elle a fait preuve. S'adressant à elle, il lui dit : "Tes péchés sont pardonnés". C'est sa foi au Christ miséricordieux qui l'a sauvée. Elle a cru qu'il était son Sauveur. C'est une provocation pour nous tous : les nombreux pardons que nous avons reçus sont un appel à rejeter les parole méprisantes et à mettre plus d'amour dans notre vie.

En ce dimanche, nous sommes invités à nous tourner vers celui qui veut nous faire miséricorde à tous. Souvent on entend certains disent : "Nous ne savons pas si Dieu voudra d'eux car nous sommes pecheurs." Nous devons leur répondre par cette parole de Saint Paul : "Là où le péché a abondé, l'amour a surabondé". Il faut le dire et le redire : Dieu nous veut tous avec lui car il nous aime tous.
