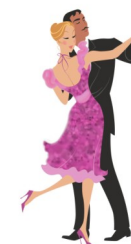

Ce n'est qu'un conte. Mais il rejoint les textes bibliques de ce dimanche. Quand Dieu envoie le prophète Élie au désert, ce n'est pas pour convertir mais pour mendier. Et c'est à une pauvre veuve qu'il fait appel. Contrairement au mendiant de Tagore, elle donne tout le peu dont elle dispose. Et c'est avec ce peu que le Seigneur a réalisé de grandes choses. Sa farine et son huile ne s'épuisèrent pas. Pour nous chrétiens, cette veuve est le visage de la foi qui partage. Comme le dira plus tard l'apôtre saint Jacques : "Moi c'est par mes œuvres que je te montrerai ma foi."

L'Évangile insiste aussi sur la pauvreté des moyens que Dieu emploie : quand il prend la condition humaine, il fait tout à l'envers : il naît dans une étable, il fréquente les pécheurs ; il juge sévèrement ceux qui donnent beaucoup au temple pour se faire remarquer ; il vante les mérites d'une pauvre veuve qui n'a rien mais qui donne tout. Ce qui est étonnant dans cet évangile, c'est la première place donnée aux petits, aux exclus, à ceux qui sont les derniers en ce monde. Par contre, il a des paroles très dures contre certains scribes qui ne cherchent qu'à être bien vus sur les places publiques, dans les synagogues et les dîners. Ils dévorent les biens des veuves au lieu de leur venir en aide. C'était d'autant plus grave qu'elles étaient réduites à la misère. En agissant ainsi, ils trahissent leur fonction et ne peuvent servir de modèle.

En ce dimanche, nous penserons aussi aux familles endeuillées, aux enfants orphelins et à tous les grands blessés. Au cours de cette Eucharistie, nous nous tournons vers toi Seigneur : Apprends-nous à donner le meilleur de nous-mêmes. Que toute notre vie soit vraiment remplie de ton amour pour toi et pour tous nos frères. Amen
