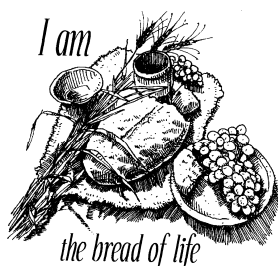

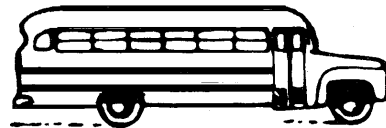

### A word from \_\_\_\_\_ your Pastor...

Many of you are aware we recently completed a major renovation of Gregg's Pantry, doubling the capacity. If you've done some significant remodeling to your own home, you know that sometimes the original budget can all too easily get eclipsed by the actual cost as the project unfolds. The expansion was not immune to this phenomenon. The project was originally budgeted for \$15,000, with the actual total being much closer to \$20,000. To help absorb the overage, I've made the decision to take the remaining funds from the capital campaign to cover the final bill; thereby leaving our Outreach Ministry with more of a financial cushion to be able to purchase food for the pantry (as well as financial assistance). For the sake of transparency, the Parish Finance Council was sought for their input and approval, and their response was unanimously affirmative. Archbishop Gregory also approved this re-allocation.

The mission of Gregg's Pantry is a vital one and I want to thank all of you for your continued support and generosity.
