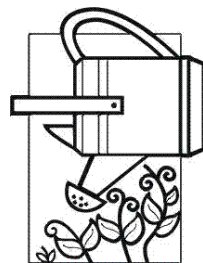

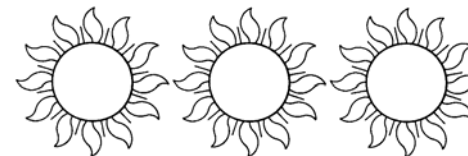

**Charitable Gift Annuities give you additional income:**

If you are over 65 and have \$10,000 or more to invest, possibly from a CD that is coming due, you may want a Charitable Gift Annuity which will give you higher rates than a CD. This will give you a large tax deduction and provide you with quarterly fixed payments for the rest of your life. Here are some sample rates based on your age: Age 65 - 4.7%; Age 70 - 5.1%; Age 75 - 5.8%; Age 80 - 6.8%; Age 85 - 7.8%; Age 90 and older - 9%. Upon your passing, the remainder of the Gift Annuity can go to your parish endowment fund and other charities.
