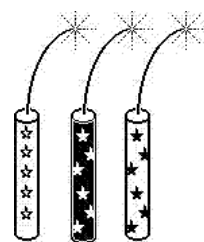

Family Friends are volunteers who provide friendly encouragement to a family of refugees as they become familiar with life in the U.S. They support newly-arrived refugees by helping them learn & adapt to American culture & become familiar with the local community. They will also help refugees with basic life skills such as managing household affairs, going through their mail, & practicing English & language skills, as well as other related activities according to need & interest. Family Friends must commit to a minimum of 2 hours per week for 4 months & will meet with refugees based on their individual schedules.
