Dominicans Continue 800th Jubilee Celebration

Brother Minlib Dallh, O.P.– a scholar of Christian and Islam relations– will be the featured preacher during Evening Prayer for St. Dominic at 7:00PM, Monday, August 8th at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish (25 Boulevard NE, Atlanta) as part of a yearlong series honoring the Order of Preachers (aka "the Dominicans"). The service will also include the ritual of admission into the Dominican family for new members of the Atlanta-based Dominican Laity Group of the Holy Cross and Madonna of the Rosary. A member of the Atlanta community of friars, Brother Minlib was selected earlier this year to begin a five-year term as a His Majesty King Abdullah II Ibn Al Husein of Jordan Fellow for "The Study of Love in Religion" at Regent's Park College, Oxford, United Kingdom. The Dominican friars in the Archdiocese of Atlanta– who are serving at the Emory University Catholic Center and at Our Lady of Lourdes– are taking part in the worldwide celebration of the Jubilee 800th anniversary of the Order of Preachers with a series of sung Evening Prayer and preaching events honoring four emblematic Dominican saints and featuring the Our Lady of Lourdes Choir. St. Thomas Aquinas was honored in January, and St. Catherine of Siena in April. The fourth and final Evening Prayer will be for the patron of the Southern Dominican Province, St. Martin de Porres, on November 3th.
