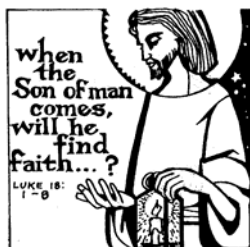

Gifts of IRA's: IRAs are not the best asset to leave our children due to the amount of taxes they might have to pay. A better option is to name the parish endowment fund as a beneficiary on your IRA. Also if you are over 70 1/2, you can make a direct transfer from your IRA to the parish endowment fund and this would not be taxed or counted in any way as taxable income.
