3ème Dimanche de l'Avent A

Le troisième dimanche de l'Avent est aussi appelé dimanche de Gaudete. En effet, dans le Missel romain, l'introït de la messe de ce dimanche commence par la phrase latine suivante: « Gaudete in Domino semper: iterum dico, gaudete » (« Réjouissez-vous toujours dans le Seigneur; je le répète, réjouissez-vous! »). Cette phrase rappelle la joie de l'Église dans l'attente de l'avènement du Christ. C'est pourquoi les vêtements liturgiques, violets pendant tout le temps de l'Avent, peuvent exceptionnellement être roses ce jour-là. Dieu nous invite à entrer dans sa joie, car le jour de notre salut approche. Jean-Baptiste nous prépare à l'accueillir. On allume la troisième bougie de la couronne de l'Avent qui symbolise la joie du roi David. l'ancêtre de Jésus. apprenant de la bouche du prophète Nathan qu'il serait l'ancêtre du Sauveur. Cette bougie célèbre l'alliance que Dieu a faite avec lui, sa famille et sa descendance, et la promesse merveilleuse que redira l'ange Gabriel lorsqu'il annoncera la naissance de Jesus à Marie.
