Notes From The Catholic Foundation

Why do retirement accounts make good gifts to the parish? IRAs, 401Ks and other retirement accounts are taxable to heirs unless the heir is a charity. Taxes on these funds can be up to 60% or more. It is better to leave insurance policies to children because they go directly to the child at death with no taxes due. If you name the parish endowment as the beneficiary or one of the beneficiaries of your retirement account, you will not need to pay taxes on that portion of the distribution.
