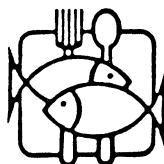

Haitian Corner

Frères et Soeurs Bonsoir!

Aujourd'hui est 5è Dimanche de Careme et nous sommes deja à huit jours de la Semaine sainte. Une fois de plus le regard va se porter davantage sur le mystère pascal. Le Christ va passer de sa souffrance terristique à sa vie de gloire. La résurrection de Lazare est un signe prémonitoire. Et Paul nous dira que, par le baptême, un passage similaire qui se réalise en nous. Nous passons d'une vie sous l'emprise de la chair à une vie sous l'emprise de l'Esprit.

Dans l'évangile de Jean, c'est Jésus qui déclare à Marthe: "... Celui qui croit en moi, même s'il meurt, vivra; et tout homme qui vit et qui croit en moi ne mourra jamais..." Il n'empêche que Lazare est mort. Jésus dira plus précisément qu'il dort. Quel acte de foi de la part de Marthe! Pour nous, aujourd'hui, Jésus est la « Résurrection » et la « Vie ». C'est par Lui que nous avons la vie de l'Esprit Saint reçue au baptême. Sans lui, nous sommes incapable de dépasser certains seuils dans nos vies. C'est Lui, Jésus, qui peut intervenir, qui peut aller au-delà de nos épreuves, de nos croix, que nous sommes incapable de changer et auxquelles nous ne pourrions donner sens, c'est-à-dire valeur de vie éternelle. Marthe a fait confiance même si son frère était mort. Cette scène de la Parole de Dieu nous est donnée pour que nos yeux aillent au-delà des apparences. Jésus peut faire éclater les frontières étroites qui nous tiennent dans la mort.
