Welcome to Our New Auxiliary Bishop

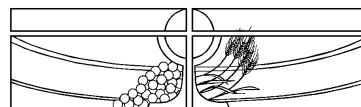

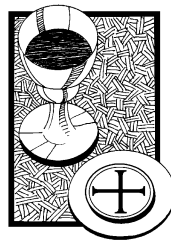
