Le Saint Sacrement du Corps et du Sang du Christ Frères et Soeurs Bonsoir!

Ce Dimanche nous célébrons le Saint Sacrement du Corps et du Sang du Christ, autrefois Fete Dieu. En cette fête du Saint-Sacrement, l'Église nous invite à prendre toujours plus conscience de la présence active chez nous, parmi nous, de Jésus ressuscité. Il est vraiment là, Jésus, vivant..., présent..., et agissant..., avec ce corps qu'il a reçu de Marie, ce corps qui a été glorifié, et qui nous est donné en nourriture pour faire grandir en nous l'enfant de Dieu, que nous sommes depuis le baptême.

L'Eucharistie est le don que Jésus-Christ nous fait de son Corps, de son Sang, de son Âme et de sa Divinité sous les apparences du pain et du vin. Il s'offre à nous à chaque messe.
