Fr. Gregory Boyle to Speak at OLA

Thursday, July 27th at 7:00PM in the church. Jesuit Father Gregory J. Boyle is the founder of Homeboy Industries in Los Angeles, CA and the author of the 2010 New York Times bestseller, *Tattoos on the Heart: The Power of Boundless Compassion*, and he is the subject of a 2012 documentary, *G-Dog*. From 1986-92, he served as pastor of Dolores Mission Church which was at the time the poorest Catholic parish in LA. Fr. Boyle and parish and community members created an alternative school/day care program for the gang-involved youth. In 1988, he created Jobs for the Future, which has since become the independent non-profit organization, Homeboy Industries. Today, Homeboy Industries employs and trains former gang members in a range of social enterprises and provides critical social services to over 10,000 people annually. Suggested Donation: \$10.
