Gifts of IRA's: IRAs are not the best asset to leave your children due to the amount of taxes they might have to pay. You can name your parish endowment fund as a beneficiary of your IRA. Simply call your IRA administrator and ask for a change of beneficiary form. This is simple and will benefit the parish for years to come. You can do the same with a 401K or any other type of retirement plan you have. Also if you are over 70 1/2 you can make a direct transfer from your IRA to the parish endowment fund, and this would not be taxed or counted in any way as taxable income.
