The African Neuropsychology Battery Project

We are recruiting volunteers for a project to develop tests of cognitive abilities like concentration, memory, and thinking skills, specifically for African immigrants to the U.S. Such tests are needed when people suffer injuries or illnesses affecting the brain. Currently no tests of these abilities are available for African immigrants, which can result in incorrect diagnosis should they suffer a brain injury. If you are healthy, with no history of medical conditions that affect the brain, you may be eligible to volunteer for this project. We are specifically seeking healthy volunteers from Nigeria, the Ivory Coast, Ghana, Ethiopia, Congo, Kenya, Zambia, Tanzania, Uganda, and Angola. We are also seeking African-American and non-Hispanic white volunteers. Participation will take approximately 2 hours for 1 test session, and can be done at either of two locations convenient for the volunteer. Volunteers receive \$25-\$50 for their participation, depending upon how many test sessions they complete. Fifth Annual Empty Bowls Project

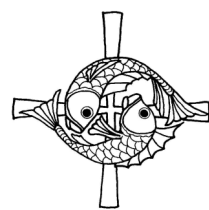
