2018 Good Friday Pilgrimage (Urban Stations of the Cross)

The 38th annual Ecumenical Good Friday Pilgrimage (Urban Way of the Cross) sponsored by the Archdiocese of Atlanta's Office of Justice & Peace Ministries is scheduled for Friday, March 30th, 9:00AM-12:00 noon. This multilingual walking prayer is a moving experience that includes scripture readings, reflections, prayer and music as we remember the passion of Christ and the social injustices in our world today. The 2-mile route is considered wheel chair accessible, but please keep in mind that not all of the sidewalks along the route are smooth or wide. The pilgrimage will begin at the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception, located at 48 Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, SW, Atlanta 30303. We will gather at 8:45AM and begin our journey with an opening prayer and reflection at 9:00AM by Auxiliary Bishop Bernard Shlesinger. We will conclude at approximately noon at the crypt of Martin Luther King Jr. with a reflection and closing prayer. Buses will be available to return participants to our start point. Participants are encouraged to car-pool or use public transportation as parking is limited.
