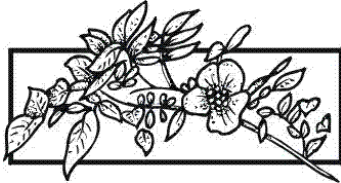

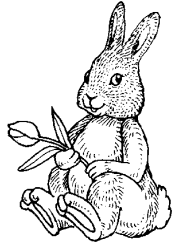

**Increase your retirement income, receive a tax deduction and leave a gift to the parish:** You can accomplish this by creating a Charitable Gift Annuity. You need to be 65 or older and have \$10,000 or more. You will receive quarterly payments for the rest of your life. The rate of return is based on your age when you establish the annuity. Some sample rates include: 65 - 4.7%; 70 - 5.1%; 75 - 5.8%; 80 - 6.8%; 85 - 7.8%; 90 or older 9%.
