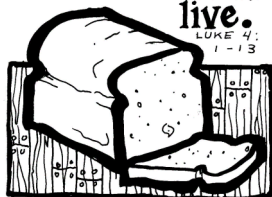
## 2019 Archbishop's Annual Appeal
